If your publication falls within the scope of Plan S or Horizon Europe and you publish in Green open access: Retain the copyright on your author version (under CC-BY licence)

If you are the corresponding author:

You can **add the following sentense** to the letter accompagnying your submission and/or in the "Acknowledgments" of your publication:

"This research was funded, in whole or in part, by [Organisation Name, Grant number]. For the purpose of open access, the author has applied a CC-BY public copyright licence to any Author Manuscript version arising from this submission."

You must then deposit immediately your author version (or post-print) in an open access repository (i.e. HAL)
